SIMON DINNERSTEIN, NA, JUROR AND JUDGE

Simon Dinnerstein, NA, counts 21 solo exhibitions; he received a Fulbright Fellowship to Germany; the Rome Prize for living and working in Italy at the American Academy in Rome; a Louis Comfort Tiffany Grant, the Ingram Merrill Award for Painting; a New York State Foundation for the Arts Grant; and three Childe Hassam Purchase Awards from the American Academy of Arts and Letters. In 1999-2000, a retrospective of his work toured the country sponsored, in part, by a grant from the Robert Lehman Foundation.

Two monographs, The Art of Simon Dinnerstein, University of Arkansas Press (1990) and Simon Dinnerstein: Paintings and Drawings, Hudson Hills Press (2000), have been published on the artist's work. In the first monograph, George Tooker, the noted American artist, wrote, "Simon Dinnerstein paints with a reverence for life that is rare. The radiance of his light can transform reality into a presence that is essential, mythic and dreamlike."

A third book, entitled *The Suspension of Time: Reflections on Simon Dinnerstein and The Fulbright Triptych* will be published in the spring of 2011 (Milkweed Editions, Minneapolis). This book is an anthology of 44 essays on *The Fulbright Triptych*; it was written by art historians, authors, poets, composers, historians, artists, etc. It is the only book length treatment solely devoted to a contemporary painting by a living artist.

A member of the National Academy of Design for the past 30 years, Dinnerstein is represented in New York by Staempfli Gallery and ACA Galleries. He resides in Park Slope, Brooklyn. He has recently completed a series of high-quality giclee prints.
